

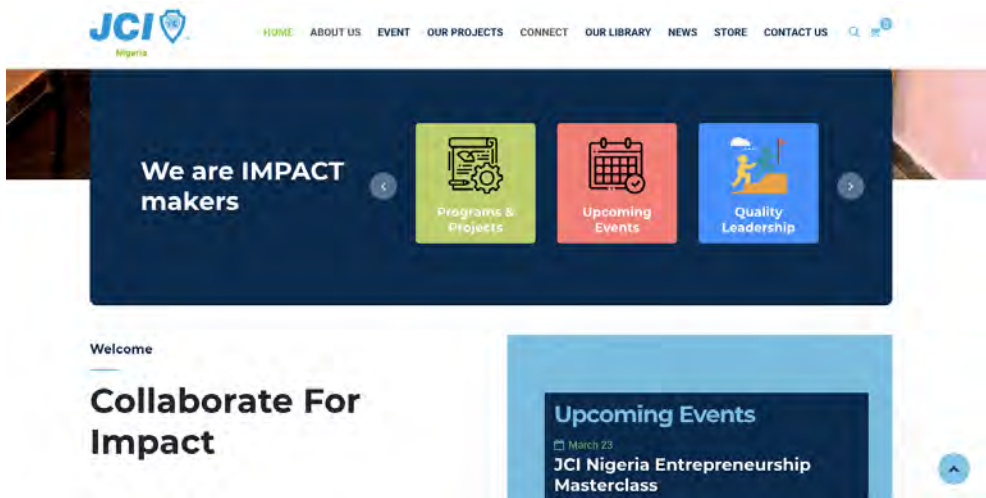
FEBRUARY Impact Report

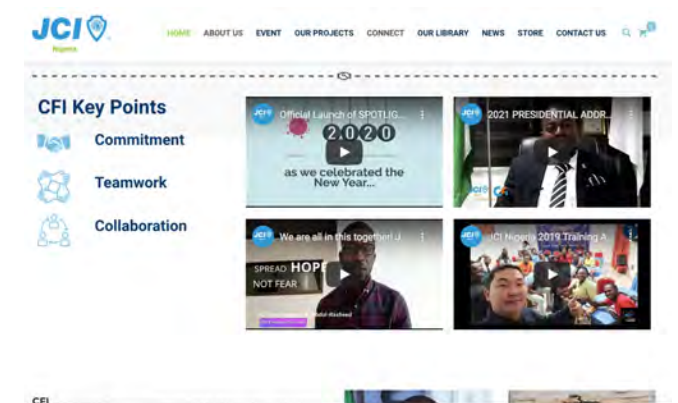
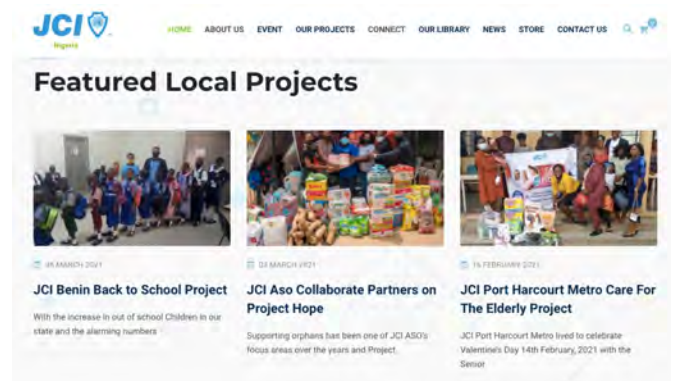

On the 4th of February, I, alongside JCI Ambassador Aina Segun Aina, JCI Ambassador Desmond Umukoro (President, JCI Abuja Unity) and Peter Emmanuel paid a courtesy visit to the **Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC)** Headquarters, Zone 3 Abuja. We received a warm reception from the Deputy Corps Marshall of the FRSC in person of **Mr H. Z. Fuomsuk** in company of other high-ranking corps marshals.



The meeting was to strengthen discussions on the ongoing partnership proposition with the FRSC on the **JCI Nigeria Defensive Driving Project**.

FRSC was receptive towards our proposition and requested that the National Organisation also consider a project on Child restraint. After much deliberation, the meeting ended with an agreement that JCI Nigeria prepares and sends a **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)** to the FRSC to formalize the partnership process.



I also visited the **Abuja Chamber of Commerce and Industry** alongside some delegates on the 12th of February. We were received by the President of the Chamber in person of **Alh. Abubakar Al Mujtaba Gummi**, the Director General – **Madam Victoria Akai** and the CEO, African Railway Consulting LTD – **Mr Olawale Rasheed**. The meeting was to seek areas of collaboration with the chamber in line with our focus for the year.



On the 19th of February, I embarked on a visit to the Lagos office of the **International Chamber of Commerce (ICC)** at Ikeja, Lagos State. I was accompanied by JCI Nigeria Executive Secretary – **Adeyemo Adeonipekun**, JCI Nigeria 2017 President – **JCI Senator Richard Ojo**, and the Secretariat Executive Assistant – **Susan Goler**. We were warmly received by the representatives of the ICC, led by the Secretary General in person of **Mrs Bunmi Osuntuyi**, the Director of programs– **Seyi Yusuf**, Training officer– Deji.

The Secretary General expressed her gratitude to JCI Nigeria for the gesture to collaborate with the Chamber. During the meeting, we requested a **50 percent discount on the ICC membership subscription fee** for JCI Nigeria members as well as the participation of the Chamber at **JCI Nigeria Economic Summit** as key areas of collaboration.

Although, these requests are still in the teething phase, nevertheless, the partnership meeting ended with the ICC stating their willingness towards a formidable partnership with JCI Nigeria.
